The Czechoslovak Academy of Sciences in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture of Czechoslovakia is planning an international conference on "Antiquity and the Present," to be held at Brno, 12-16 April, 1966. A symposium on Mycenaean studies will constitute part of the conference.

The American Council of Learned Societies Newsletter 16 (May 1965) contains a survey of computerized research in the humanities being done in the United States. Among the projects which may be of interest are the following: Mario DiCesare, Harpur College, A metrical analysis of the epic; Murray Fowler, University of Wisconsin, A computer analysis of the Etruscan language; Richard N. Frye, Harvard University, Computer applications to Old Iranian studies; Hans G. Güterbock, University of Chicago, Analysis of a segment of the Hittite language; Eric P. Hampe, University of Chicago, A concordance of 10,000 lines of Sumerian literary texts; James T. McDonough, Jr., St. Joseph's College, A complete count of the rhythmic function of each of the words in the Iliad.

B. H. Blackwell's reports that G. L. Huxley, Achaean and Hittites, Oxford 1960, has been reprinted. It is available from Blackwell's for 5 shillings, plus postage.

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Among the items mentioned are an interesting Anatolian female figurine (pl. 11), as well as other Anatolian ceramics. Of special note are two Mycenaean gold plates, "provenant d'une fouille clandestine," one (pl. 15) 0.17 cm in diameter and 0.023 cm thick, the other (pl. 16) 0.197 cm in diameter and from 0.018 to 0.028 cm thick.
