Projects outside the Aegean must have a direct relationship to Aegean prehistory in order to be considered for funding. INSTAP does not provide funds to support students obtaining degrees. In addition, Excavation Directors only may also apply for funds for technical archaeological services for publication preparation. Projects which are finished with excavation and are preparing material for publication are eligible. INSTAP also hopes to have available a group of specialists to supplement those already assembled by a Project Director or to provide a complete publication team should a Director wish.
